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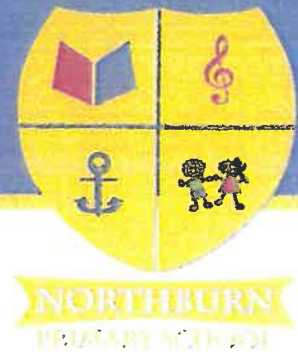
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will also provide a place to sit and enjoy the world around us, with a selection of plants and the introduction of bird feeders to attract more wildlife.
