

This year the PTA are organising an online Christmas raffle. We are looking for the following donations to make up Christmas hampers for prizes.

Nursery/Reception – Christmas sweets or a small Christmas decoration.

KS1 (classes 4, 5 & 6) – Christmas cakes, puddings or biscuits.

KS2 (classes 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13) - Christmas bottles.

If you can please bring donations into the school entrance and put them in the boxes provided from Monday 16th until Wednesday 18th November.

A link to purchase raffle tickets will be sent to you at the end of November.

Christmas Dinner, Jumper Day & Decorate a Bauble.

This year, due to staffing and space in the hall, we will need do this over 2 days:

Nursery, Reception and KS1 -Thursday 10th December.

KS2 - Friday 11th December (a separate letter will be sent for you to let us know if your child wishes to have Christmas lunch).

On the day, your child can wear a Christmas jumper or colourful top but should still wear the rest of their school uniform as usual. They will have the chance to make a Christmas decoration which they will be able to take home. We ask for a £1 donation. All money raised will be donated to the 'Save the Children' Christmas Jumper Appeal.

We ask that all children in Nursery, Reception and KS1 bring a packed lunch on Friday 11th December in order to accommodate KS2 having their Christmas lunch.

Christmas Parties:

- Nursery Monday 14th December (The party will take place within their usual session; children who attend 30 hours will have their party in the afternoon.)
- Reception (classes 2 & 3) Monday 14th December (in the afternoon)
- Upper Key Stage 2 (classes 10, 11, 12 & 13) Tuesday 15th December (in the afternoon).
- Lower Key Stage 2 (classes 7, 8, 9) Wednesday 16th December (in the afternoon).
- Key Stage 1 (classes 4, 5 & 6) Thursday 17th December (in the afternoon).

Your child should come to school on their party day **wearing comfortable party clothes** and **footwear suitable for outside breaks and active party games**. Children will be decorating a party bag to bring home. They should bring this back into school on their party day with a snack or treat for themselves to have during the party. We will provide drinks. Your child will have their usual school dinner or packed lunch The party snack is **extra** so doesn't need to be huge!

N.B Party food must not contain nuts or nut products as we have children with nut allergies in school.

Last day of term is Friday 18th December. Children return to school on Tuesday 5th January.
