Uniform list

School sweatshirt/cardigan in blue (available from Cloud9 Leisure with our school logo). White polo shirt Grey trousers or skirt Blue gingham dress Grey shorts School caps Black school shoes

Indoor PE Kit

White tee shirt Black shorts

Outdoor PE Kit (Years 1 to 6)

As above Tracksuit (plain), dark jogging suit or dark sweatshirt and trousers Training Shoes (Winter & Summer)(Years 5 & 6 football boots and shin Pads Oct – April)

Swimming – Year 4

One piece swimsuit Swimming trunks for boys

Football shirts cannot be worn except on non-uniform days

Further details about expected school uniform.

<u>Shoes</u>

Shoes should not have any height to the heels as these are not suitable for playtimes. No canvas fashion shoes should be worn. If your child wears boots or wellingtons to come to school during the winter then they should have their school shoes to change into on arrival at school. PE in the hall is done in bare feet.

If your child wears sandals in the summer they should be substantial and support the child's foot. We appreciate that it is not always possible to buy black sandals.

<u>Jewellery</u>

No jewellery can be worn in school. Jewellery can be dangerous when worn in technology or PE. Some jewellery brought in to school is expensive and we cannot be responsible for its safe keeping. Wearing jewellery can distract children from learning. This means that apart from a wrist watch the children should wear no additional items including all wristbands and earring studs.

Children who have their ears pierced must also leave their earrings at home.

<u>Hair</u>

Extreme hairstyles and hair accessories are **not** to be worn in school. Designs shaved into the hair and unnatural dyed hair should also **not** be worn during term time. Long hair should always be tied back. This is especially important for PE.

Cloakrooms

Our cloakrooms are quite small and it is a struggle to keep them tidy. You can help us by:-

- Using small PE bags which lie flat when empty.
- Using school book bags
- Naming **ALL** of your child's property so that it can be returned immediately to its owner.
